

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF MAR CHRYSOSTOM**

### **FEEES**

Tuition fee and all other special fees of the college will be collected in two installments. Besides this, all students will have to pay the following special fees.

1. University Exam Fee
2. Record fee
3. Uniform fee
4. Magazine fee
5. Community camp fee
6. Seminar fee
7. Picnic fee
8. Bus fee
9. Convocation fee

Students are advised to keep all receipt carefully issued for payments made in the college, till the end of the academic year.

1. Fees shall be paid on the data specified in two installments.
  - ⊗ First installment will be paid on the time of admission.
  - ⊗ Second installment will be paid before 10<sup>th</sup> December.
2. Absence with or without leave from the college shall not be an excuse for non - payment of fee at proper time. Students failing to pay the fees on the prescribed dates have to pay fine.
3. If a student leaves the college after enrolment he/she shall have to pay the total course fee as per the schedule of fees.
4. Examination fee & fee for mark list will be collected during the academic year as per the norm prescribed by the University.



## **I. WORKING DAYS AND CLASS HOURS**

There shall be 6 working days in a week and 6 hours in a day. It may vary according to be needs. The day begins with prayer and morning assembly at 9.20 am. and ends at 4.10 pm. The forenoon session are divided into three periods and afternoon session three periods each. Each period will begins with a silent prayer.

## **II. ATTENDANCE**

1. Teachers shall take attendance at the beginning and afternoon session.
  - a) A student coming late may be given attendance as per the discretion of the teacher concerned.
2. On every working day a list of absentees of the day may be put on the General Notice Board.
3. At the end of each month, a list will be put on the General Notice Board showing the number of days of attendance lost so far by each student and it will be intimated to the respective parents.
4. Absence from class for a period will be considered absent for the forenoon or the afternoon session.

## **III. LIBRARY RULES**

1. It is obligatory for all students in the college to be members of Library and reading room.
2. Silence must be strictly observed in the library and its premises.
3. Each students will be given a general resource utility card with which he/she can borrow two books at a time.
4. The applications for books are to be made in the prescribed form available at the library. They should be handed it at the counter along with the borrower's card, one for each book.
5. Books of the reference section will not be given out on loan but they may be consulted within the library premises.

6. Readers will be responsible for any damage caused to the book or to any library property. When a book is issued to a reader it is presumed that it is in good condition unless the contrary is pointed out immediately.

7. If a book is damaged or lost by a member he/she will have to replace it or pay three times of the cost of the book including postage. A greater penalty may be imposed according to the circumstances.

8. Members are not allowed to sub-lend the books of the library.

9. All the books must be returned to the library one week before the closing date of each year.

10. Books not exceeding three, may be taken out for Onam and Christmas holidays. All such books must be returned on the date of re-opening.

11. Outsiders are not allowed to enter or remain in the library without the permission of the principal.

#### **IV. RESIDENCE OF STUDENTS – (HOSTEL)**

a. Accommodation facilities are available for the students those who are far away from the college and they are instructed to stay in the College Hostel or recognized Hostels approved by the Principal.

b. College office should be informed of the correct home address as well as local address to which any communication may be sent.

c. The written approval of the principal should be obtained before changing the residence once approved.

d. Students leaving the hostel or remaining in the hostel in working days without the permission of the Principal and hostel warden will be treated as serious misconduct.

#### **V. LEAVE RULES**

i. A student requiring leave for a class or portion of class must apply for it to the teacher before the class begins.

- ii. A student requiring leave for a whole session or more must apply for it in writing to the Principal.
- iii. Application for leave will not be considered unless they are in prescribed form and the leave application form in the calendar is filled by the applicant.
- iv. Application for leave should reach the office at least by 1.00 pm. before the day for which leave is applied.
- v. Leave should not be taken in combination with holidays.
- vi. Students who are absent without any information for 3 or more consecutive days should submit an immediate written explanation of their absence to the Principal.
- vii. Leave should not be availed of as a matter of course. Proper and acceptable reason should be given for the leave.
- viii. No student will be granted more than 5 days leave during the academic year. When leave is applied for owing to sickness, production of a proper medical certificate may be required.
- ix. A student will forfeit one day's leave for every four time he/she is marked late.
- x. If a student absents himself for five consecutive working days without applying for leave his/her name will ordinary be removed from the name list of the college.
- xi. After entering the college campus, leave shall be allowed only with the presence of parents or letter duly signed with them.

## **VI. ISSUE OF T.C AND CERTIFICATES**

- ❖ Transfer Certificates will be issued only after the payment of all dues to the college.

- ❖ A student past or present, applying for certificates of transfer, character, age, marks, etc. shall submit the written request to the Principal.
- ❖ Stipulated fee must be paid for the issue of certificates.
- ❖ A notice of not less than 24 hours is necessary for the issue of a certificate.
- ❖ No certificate will be sent by post unless the charge for transmission by registered post is prepaid.

## **VII. UNIFORM**

Students should wear uniform on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and also on days of national importance as per the instruction given by the principal. All Wednesday and Saturday they can wear colour sarees.

## **VIII. ETHICAL AND RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION**

It is obligatory for all students to attend classes in Religious Instruction / Ethics.

## **IX. GOOD MANNERS AND BEHAVIOUR**

1. All the students are expected to be exemplary in their conduct and character.
2. Students who have no class should not loiter on the veranda during class hours. They must be in the library as per the direction of the principal.
3. Students are forbidden to attend or to organize any meeting in the college which is not approved by the College authorities or to collect money for any such purpose. They should not circulate among the students any notice or petition or poster anywhere in the college premises without the written sanction of the principal.



